SECTION .0600 - CURRICULA

21 NCAC 14T .0601 COSMETIC ART CURRICULA

- (a) Cosmetic art schools shall develop and submit to the Board a curriculum of each discipline to be taught at the school. The curriculum, once approved by the Board's standards listed in Rules .0602-.0610, of this Section shall be adhered to and lessons developed from the approved curriculum.
- (b) Blood exposure and infection control evaluations must be passed with a score of 100 percent before a student may perform a mannequin or live model performance. Before a student may perform a live model performance the student shall pass the respective mannequin performance evaluation plan.
- (c) Performances shall be defined as the systematic completion of the steps for safe and effective cosmetic art services to a client.
- (d) All cosmetic art students shall receive training on Safety Data Sheets prepared by the manufacturer on all products used by the school's students in performances.
